In compliance with Section 65(13) of the Constitution of Botswana, we hereby submit to you a report on the activities and processes leading to the preparation for and on the conduct of the 1999 General Elections held on 16th October, 1999. This followed the dissolution of Parliament on 24th August 1999. On 26th August 1999, His Excellency issued a Writ of Election for each of the forty constituencies. He declared 24th September 1999, as nomination day and 16th October 1999, as polling day for all constituencies in which there was a contest.

In terms of Section 5 (1) of the Local Councils (Conduct of Elections) Regulations, the Honourable Minister of Local Government, Lands and Housing issued 406 election instruments for the nomination and election of representatives of City/Town and District Councils. The instruments also designated the 24th September 1999 and the 16th October 1999 as nomination day and polling day respectively.

We greatly appreciate the support and cooperation received from your office, which significantly contributed to the delivery of successful elections.

INTRODUCTION

The Independent Electoral Commission (IEC) was established by Section 65A of the Constitution of Botswana in 1997 (Constitution (Amendment) Act 1997), which also provides for the composition of the Commission.

The Commission consists of a Chairman and a Deputy Chairman appointed directly by the Judicial Service Commission, and five other members appointed from a list of persons recommended by the All Party Conference.

As stipulated in Section 65A, the Chairman of the Commission shall be a Judge of the High Court. The Deputy Chairman shall be a Legal Practitioner.

According to Section 65A of the Constitution of Botswana the functions of the Commission are:

- to conduct and supervise elections of the elected members of the National Assembly and members of a local authority.
- to conduct a referendum.
- to ensure that elections are conducted efficiently, properly, freely and fairly.
- to give instructions and directives to the Secretary of the Commission in regard to the exercise of his functions under the Constitution and Electoral Laws generally.
- to perform such other functions as Parliament may by law prescribe.

The 1999 General Elections were the first the Commission conducted. The Commission made every effort to fulfil its obligations despite its limited capacity and time as will be appreciated in this report.

DISSOLUTION OF PARLIAMENT AND ISSUANCE OF WRIT OF ELECTION

His Excellency, the President, dissolved the National Assembly on, 24th August 1999, and on 26th August 1999, he issued a Writ of Election for each of the forty constituencies. In these writs, His Excellency declared 24th September 1999, as nomination day and 16th October 1999, as polling day for all constituencies in which there was a contest.

In terms of Section 5(1) of the Local Councils (Conduct of Elections) Regulations,

the Honourable Minister of Local Government, Lands and Housing issued 406 election instruments for the nomination and election of representatives of City/Town and District Councils. The instruments also designated the 24th September, 1999 and the 16th October, 1999 as nomination day and polling day respectively.

NOMINATIONS

Presidential

In compliance with Section 7 (1) of the Presidential Elections (Supplementary Provisions) Act, the Secretary of the IEC appointed Authenticating Officers (Government Gazette Notice No. 44 dated 16th July 1999). The appointed Authenticating Officers included: District Commissioners, District Officers, and Police Officers.

The Chief Justice as the Returning Officer for Presidential Elections received the nomination papers of the presidential candidates on 18th September 1999 between 1000 hrs and 1300 hrs and 1400hrs and 1700 hrs at the High Court in Lobatse. Four Leaders of political parties submitted their nominations. All four were declared validly nominated as candidates for election to the Office of President. They were:

Parliamentary and Council

Parliamentary and Local Government nominations were held, in terms of Sections 32 of the Electoral Act, on the 24th September, 1999, in all the 40 constituencies and 406 polling districts.

The numbers of the duly nominated parliamentary candidates were as follows:

Out of 138 validly nominated candidates 27 obtained less than one-twentieth of the total number of votes cast in his/her constituency, and therefore lost their deposits. *See appendix B for details.*

A few problems emerged during nominations at certain centres; and these included among others:

- (a) Failure by some candidates to bring their full compliment of supporters;
- (b) Failure in some cases by supporters to bring their identity cards and
- (c) Candidates arriving after the stipulated hour.

Details of Parliament and Local Government nominations are included at appendices A and F respectively.

VOTER REGISTRATION AND PREPARATION OF ROLLS

Preparations for voter registration started early in 1998 with a call to Principal Registration Officers to review the adequacy or otherwise of the existing polling stations. This exercise resulted in thirty-six additional polling stations being established.

The approval of the Ministry of Education was sought and secured to engage school teachers as Registration Officers during vacation. The appointed teachers underwent a thorough training in preparation for their role as Registration Officers.

The continuous registration exercise was undertaken by clerks appointed by Principal Registration Officers. The last supplementary general registration was carried out by the out - of - school youths.

The general registration started on 15th August 1998 and ended on the 29th August, 1998. In total 300,480 Batswana were registered. The period between 3rd September 1998 and 31st December 1998 was devoted to continuous registration.

This was followed by two exercises of continuous registration taking place between 4th January 1999 and 31st March 1999 and between 10th May, 1999 and 9th July 1999. This was done so that voters rolls for each registration could be prepared and published. There were also two additional general registrations, held between 17th April, 1999 and 1st May, 1999 and between 17th July and 31st July 1999. The last was done to allow eligible Batswana to register and vote using their expired National Identity card (Ormang).

The Constitutional Amendment Act, 1997, Section 4, subsection (a), permits citizens who have attained the age of eighteen years to register. This landmark event added approximately 268,500 first time eligible voters. The number of first time eligible voters is based on population projections for ages eighteen through twenty-five years. Within the age group of eighteen to twenty years, there was approximately 21,288 registered voters. *Age and Gender Statistics are given in appendices I and J respectively.*

Again, for the first time, registration was extended to Batswana residing outside the country. Eligible voters residing in the Republic of South Africa, United Kingdom, United States of America, Namibia, and Zimbabwe were given a chance to register. Only 1,395 Batswana registered under this exercise out of an estimated 17,400 despite efforts by Botswana Missions to inform all concerned of the registration dates in good time. *See appendix K for details on external voter registration.*

Upon completion of each general registration, and continuous registration at the different registration centres, records were brought into a central point where data was captured in the computer. A copy of the roll was submitted to Principal Registration Officers for public inspection and subsequent certification by the Secretary.

The overall number of registered Batswana came to 459,662. This exceeded the Commission's targeted figure of 450,000. *Registration and vote trend statistics are included at appendix L.*

By and large the officers did a good job. However, there were isolated cases where registration books were destroyed or misplaced with a few voters registered in them; and where registration forms were left blank; and cases where voters' identity was not recorded at all.

Obviously, in the latter cases there was no way that the details of the voter could be captured in the database. Where efforts to trace such voters failed, their names were not included in the voters' rolls.

What has become clear is that Batswana generally have not taken seriously the importance of inspecting the voters' rolls when they are published; for if they did, the discrepancies alluded to above would have been corrected.

The computerisation of voters' rolls has been useful in quite a number of respects. It has among others:

- eliminated double registration.
- ensured that only Batswana register as voters.
- assisted the National Registration Office to identify duplicated identification registrations.
- ensured that under-age Batswana did not register.

The accuracy of the voters rolls was dependent upon the information available at the national registration system. It was important, for example, that Batswana should submit details of deceased voters to the National Registration Office as this consequently affect the status of the voters' rolls maintained by the IEC. In some cases people carried 'wrong' OMANG numbers which invariably were then rejected by the elections computer system. This was as a result of either persons sharing national identity numbers, persons holding more than one identity card or simply erroneous recording at the voter registration points. These problems need to be addressed by all concerned.

STATE OF EMERGENCY

On the 16th of July 1999, the National Assembly amended the Electoral Act to allow those with expired identity cards (Omang) to vote. It then became necessary to organise an additional registration period. This took place from 17th July 1999 to 31st July 1999. In the meantime, the President had dissolved Parliament on the 24th August 1999, and issued the Writ of Elections on the 26th August 1999.

Were it not for this particular registration period the issuing of the Writ of Election by the President on the 26th of August 1999, would have been no more than a routine step in the election process.

In the event, when the writ was signed the rolls for the additional registration period had yet to be certified and published. The effect was to disenfranchise the 66,000 people who had registered in that period.

Reacting to this unanticipated problem the President informed the general public that it was not acceptable to him that so many people that had registered would be unable to vote.

He further stated that he had no choice but to declare a state of emergency and to recall Parliament, which had previously been dissolved, in order that it could pass a

further amendment to the Electoral Act to allow the publication of the voters roll notwithstanding the issuance of the Writ of Elections. Parliament reconvened on the 6th September 1999 for that purpose.

RECRUITMENT AND TRAINING

The staffing requirements for Election Day were based on the number of registered voters, as well as the total number of polling stations. There was an increase in both the number of registered voters as well as the number of polling stations since the 1994 General Election. Consequently, polling stations with 600 voters or less were staffed with one Presiding Officer and two Polling Officers for Parliament and two Polling Officers for local government. However, a two stream system was established for polling stations with registered voters greater than 600. Voters were assigned to stream A or B according to their voter registration number. In such instances, the staffing requirement per polling station doubled. This resulted in the allocation of two Presiding Officers, four Polling Officers for Parliament elections, and four Polling Officers for local elections.

In addition, it was estimated that not more than three Police Officers would be required per polling station. The actual number of Police Officers at each polling station was determined by the Returning Officer in consultation with the Police Commissioner. The number of Assistant Returning Officers was arrived at on the basis of the needs of the Returning Officers.

District Commissioners in consultation with the IEC Secretariat conducted the recruitment of election Officers. District Commissioners were directed to meet with Regional Senior Officers to arrange a list of capable Public Officers to serve as Presiding and Polling Officers.

The list was then submitted to the Commission for approval. Subsequently, the names of the Presiding Officers and Polling Officers were gazetted. In all, there were a total of 1,758 Presiding Officers, 4,677 Polling Officers, 41 Returning Officers and 174 Assistant Returning Officers. The strength of the Police at polling stations was between two and three Officers, depending upon the number of registered voters.

Training of Returning Officers was conducted by members of the IEC Secretariat. There were two training sessions held during the month of August 1999. A significant number of both Returning and Presiding Officers in the 1999 election served in previous elections. This provided an added advantage as these officers were familiar with most procedures.

The country was divided into two with Dibete Cordon fence as the dividing point. All Returning Officers North of Dibete Cordon fence attended training in Francistown on 13th August 1999, and Officers south of Dibete attended training in Gaborone

on 12th August 1999. The Electoral Act was the primary reference document used during training.

During the month of September 1999, a number of one-day training sessions were held throughout the country for Presiding Officers, Polling Officers and Police officers. The training sessions were conducted by either a Returning Officer or a member of the IEC Secretariat. An invitation was extended by Returning Officers to political party candidates and party agents to participate in the training sessions. Officers were provided with a manual entitled, *A Guide to Presiding Officers and Polling Officers*. Participating political candidates and agents were issued with *A Guide to Political Party Candidates*. There was also a review of relevant sections of the Electoral Act during the training sessions.

LOGISTICS

As far back as 1998 when it became clear what materials were going to be required for 1999 elections a decision to stockpile was taken.

Local companies were engaged by tender to produce the new types of polling booths and replace damaged ballot boxes enough to meet election requirements. Training and publicity materials were produced by Government Printer at cost. Camp equipment in the form of marquee tents, bed stretchers, cadac lamps and candles were ordered. Also ordered were consumable items such as ink, padlocks and keys, masking tape, sealing – wax, razor blades, sealing slots etc.

Transport requirements by type were identified, and the necessary requests made to Central Transport Organisation (CTO) Depots throughout the country. These vehicles were required for the registration exercise and for distribution of election materials wherever it was needed. Maximum care of these vehicles was exercised, especially in view of the new charging system introduced by CTO.

Where a shortage of storage facilities was experienced an additional warehouse was rented to accommodate this shortfall. The warehouse was used as a packing and distribution centre.

In 1998, a deliberate decision was taken by All-Party Conference and the government to replace counters and ballot envelopes by the use of ballot papers. The design was made in consultation with Government Printer and security features were incorporated into the ballot paper.

Because of lack of design capacity locally, the Government Printer in consultation with IEC engaged the services of a United Kingdom based company for the design assignment and production of the base stock paper. The final ballot paper was ultimately printed by a South African based company.

The ballot paper contained colours and symbols of all contesting political parties. However, for independent candidates stickers had to be produced. This also applied to some registered political parties, which made late submissions. This scenario led to a lot of logistical problems.

Upon receipt of nomination papers, which were virtually all submitted by the 29th of September 1999, it was possible to finalise plans for packing of ballot boxes. A master list of all necessary equipment for each polling station was created to ensure that adequate equipment was allocated for the respective stations. The warehouse staff, which was responsible for preparing and distributing boxes, consisted of four IEC Secretariat regular staff, and twenty-five temporary employees. This crew was capable of putting together on average 200 boxes per day.

During collection of ballot boxes, booths, and other materials by Returning Officers, they were asked to ascertain whether all pertinent materials were in the boxes. The entire process of packing and distribution took approximately two weeks to accomplish.

VOTER EDUCATION

In preparation for the 1999 General Election, the Commissioners and the Secretariat staff collectively conducted approximately 120 Kgotla meetings throughout the country. There were also efforts by various Non-Governmental Organisations (NGOs), Community Based Organisations (CBOs), political parties and other civic groups to conduct voter education. In many instances, the IEC Secretariat collaborated with the various organisations through participating in voter education seminars and providing materials and accurate information that could be passed on to the citizens of Botswana.

In addition, the IEC Secretariat hosted demonstrations of polling procedures at Agricultural Shows countrywide and participated in several call-in Radio Botswana programmes, commonly referred to as Maokaneng, to answer questions raised by members of the public. Advertisements were also placed in the print media to sensitise the electorate on both registration and voting.

The Commission is the first to admit that it could have done a better job on voter education. Unfortunately, both time and resources were not adequate. However, the Commission appreciates the importance of such activities. Consequently, plans are already underway for consultative meetings with political parties, NGOs, CBOs, and the media, designed to deepen their involvement in voter education activities. It is the intention of the IEC to provide the content for all voter education activities conducted in Botswana. This will help to eliminate any inconsistencies in information regarding the electoral process in Botswana.

In addition, it is anticipated that the Secretariat will expand to include District Election Officers (DEOs). DEOs will, among other responsibilities, develop ongoing voter education strategies for their respective districts.

POLLING DAY

According to reports submitted by Returning Officers, voters arrived at polling stations as early as 0400hrs. A majority of the Polling Stations opened at 0630 hrs and closed at 1900hrs. There were only a few instances of delayed start time. The reasons given varied from missing candidate notices to misplaced ballot box keys.

The overwhelming reason reported for polling stations closing after the designated hour was the long queues.

The voting process proved to be very slow. A variety of reasons accounted for this. For instance voters could not quickly grasp the new method of voting, particularly the elderly. Moreover, a number of voters had difficulty holding a pen and marking an X and their attempts at selecting a candidate or party usually ended outside the space provided.

Other minor difficulties occurred with the voters roll, ballot boxes, and party symbols; however, these problems were handled promptly, allowing voters to return to the business of casting their vote.

By and large the Batswana electorate continues to demonstrate patience and cooperation during elections. There were no reported incidents of election-related violence or intimidation.

EXTERNAL VOTES

For the first time, Botswana citizens residing outside the country were given the opportunity to exercise their constitutional right to vote. External voting was held on 2nd October 1999, at a high Commission, a Botswana Embassy or designated polling stations within the following countries: Republic of South Africa, United Kingdom, United States of America, Namibia and Zimbabwe.

There were thirty-six external polling stations in all. The total number of Batswana who voted was 333. A meagre 23.8 percent of the registered external voters!

Upon completion of the election, the ballot bags were sealed and escorted back to Botswana by High Commissioners and Botswana Police Officers. The arrival dates and origin of pouches containing votes were announced via Radio Botswana. Political

candidates, party agents and observers were allowed to witness the receiving and sorting of pouches.

The external votes envelopes were opened and tabulated along with the General Election ballots.

While the provision for external voting was an important attempt to extend the democratic process, its value proved to be disappointingly small and will need careful review.

OBSERVERS

There were several domestic and international observer groups and individuals requesting to monitor pre-election, election and post election activities. An accreditation letter was given to all persons interested in monitoring the elections. Their presence throughout the electoral process demonstrated to the electorate our attempts at being as transparent as possible throughout the electoral process. The Commission is awaiting feedback from the Observers and will carefully consider all recommendations for improvement and incorporate those, which the Commission deems relevant.

The Commission also recognises and appreciates the watchdog role of the media in elections. For this reason, media people were issued with letters of introduction to facilitate their movement and access to polling and counting centres. *See appendix M for list of Observers.*

COUNTING CENTRES

After the closing of the polls, ballot boxes were transported from polling stations by Presiding Officers to the designated counting centre. Present at the counting centres were Returning Officers, Assistant Returning Officers, and Police Officers. There were also political party candidates, party agents and observers present at the various counting centres.

In some instances, delays occurred because of the need to transfer ballot boxes to counting centres, especially where a counting centre was far from the polling station; the verification of ballot papers, which could not occur until all ballot boxes for a constituency had been received by the Returning Officer; the unfolding of ballot papers and reading of information; and the insistence of a re-count by candidates.

While every effort was made to make the counting procedure as transparent as possible, the Commission recognises that the process was overly long and time consuming.

RESULTS

In the 1999 General Election, 459,662 voters registered. Out of this a total of 354,466 voted. This represents a voter turnout of 77.11 percent of total registered voters.

At approximately 0100 hrs on Sunday, 17th October 1999, the first results were received by the Commission. The results continued to trickle in until the final results arrived on Monday, 18th October 1999, at approximately 2100 hrs.

The total number of rejected votes was 17,481, which translates into 4.93 percent of total votes cast. The rejections were mostly due to: placing a mark against a party not represented in the constituency or polling district, a voter marking against more than one party, marks being made outside the appropriate boxes on the ballot papers, and wrong marks being used to indicate their choice.

Five political parties contested the parliamentary elections. Out of the 40 contested constituencies, the Botswana Democratic Party won 33 seats, the Botswana National Front gained 6 and the Botswana Congress Party gained 1.

BDP was returned unopposed in 7 Polling Districts in the Local Government Elections.

On Monday 18th October 1999, the Chief Justice was informed that more than fifty percent of the Members of Parliament had declared their support for Festus G. Mogae in the Presidential Election. The Chief Justice as the Returning Officer for

the Presidential Election, declared Festus G. Mogae duly elected as President. The President took the oath of office on Wednesday 20th October, 1999.

EXPENDITURE

Considerable expenses were incurred on the acquisition of materials, supplies, personal emoluments and other election related activities/services including registration exercises, voter education workshops, and advertising and publicity. The total expenditure to date is approximately P19,000,000.

EVALUATION

The 1999 General Election was historic in many respects. Firstly, it was the first election that allowed eighteen-year-old citizens to vote. Secondly, the constitutional right to vote was extended to Batswana residing in other countries. Thirdly, the ballot paper was used for the first time in a general election. Fourthly, it was the

first General Election conducted under the auspices of the Commission.

The Commission is encouraged by the level of participation in the elections and believes that the conditions existed for a free expression of will by the electors and that the results reflect the wishes of Batswana.

The Commission recognises some of the problems it encountered during the pre-election and election periods, and has already begun addressing some of them.

Throughout various stages of the electoral process, there were international consultants and domestic organisations conducting formal evaluations. In conjunction with the anticipated feedback from evaluators and a series of consultative meetings/seminars with electoral staff, political parties and non-governmental organisations, a plan of action will be developed to map the way forward into 2004.

A report of the outcome of the workshops and the proposed plan of action will be made available for public consumption.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

The Commission wishes to place on record its sincere appreciation to the many groups and individuals who assisted it in a variety of ways throughout the entire election process.

The Commission wishes to thank especially, the Commissioner of Police and Officers, the Department of Information and Broadcasting, the Attorney General's Chambers, the district based public officers, the teachers, the Central Transport Organisation and staff, and other government ministry and department personnel who worked tirelessly during the election period to fulfil the demanding and challenging duties of election with professionalism and dedication.

The Commission also appreciates the co-operation of the political parties, the media, representatives of non-governmental organisations and representatives of civic organisations.

Special thanks go to the IEC staff for their dedication and commendable performance throughout the electoral process.

Finally, the Commission is deeply grateful to the voters for their display of maturity and commitment towards promoting democracy and in sustaining the country's independence.








% OF SEATS OBTAINED BY CONTESTING PARTIES







